**High School** - Outreach: school and community based interventions.

## What OYS Can Help With

- Risky behaviors
- Involvement with law enforcement

  - Emotional support

All services are **free** to Manchester middle and high school students.

## OYS works with youth experiencing:

Academic concern/poor grades, Anger and aggression, Bullying and fighting, Change in behavior/communication, Change in family structure/custody, Cutting/self harm, Death or loss, Divorce or marriage of a parent, Home stress, Homelessness, Isolation, Moving residence/ changing schools, Sibling tension, Substance use, Trauma, Truancy/school refusal, Victim of crime or violence, Witness to crime or violence, and more.

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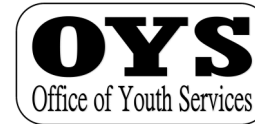
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
